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(2793) Proposal to conserve the name *Hebeloma velutipes* against *H. bakeri* (Fungi, Agaricales, Hymenogastraceae)

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(2793) ***Hebeloma velutipes*** Bruchet in Bull. Mens. Soc. Linn. Lyon 39 (6, Suppl.): 127. Jun 1970, nom. cons. prop.

Typus: France, Les Echets (Ain) (ca. 45.86°N; 04.90°E; alt. ca. 280 m), on clayey soil in deciduous woodland under *Corylus avellana*, 24 Sep 1963, *Bruchet* (LY No. BR63-20).

(=) *Hebeloma bakeri* Earle in Bull. New York Bot. Gard. 2: 342. Apr 1902, nom. rej. prop.

Typus: U.S.A., California, Stanford Univ., under *Quercus*, 4 Dec 1901, *Baker* 147 (NY barcode 00814992; isotypi: NY barcode 01946447, UC barcode 1886437).

Hebeloma velutipes is the type of *Hebeloma* sect. *Velutipes* Vesterh. (in Ann. Micol. A. G. M. T. 1: 60. 2004), from which the section takes its name. The section includes eight European species (Beker & al., *Hebeloma*: 349. 2016).

In the course of the preparation of a monograph of *Hebeloma* in North America, utilizing molecular as well as morphological approaches, we determined from examination of the holotype collection (cited above) that the name *Hebeloma bakeri* was conspecific with the well-established *Hebeloma velutipes*. This mushroom is ectomycorrhizal; recorded
